<u>Event</u>	<u>Roman Date</u>	<u>Lunar Month Date</u>
First Day of Sacred Year	April 5	Day 3 of the lunar month (postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Passover	April 18	Day 16 of the lunar month (postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Days of Unleavened Bread	April 19-25	Days 17-23 of the lunar month (postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Pentecost	June 12	One week later than it would be if the postponements had not been observed
Feast of Trumpets	September 29	Day 3 of the lunar month (postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Day of Atonement	October 8	Day 12 of the lunar month (postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Feast of Tabernacles	October 13-19	Days 17-23 of the lunar month (postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Last Great Day	October 20	Day 24 of the lunar month (postponed 2 days for religious convenience)

The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong. The Jewish calendar is used to provide the start of a month. The inherent Jewish postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Jewish customs, are accepted as divinely inspired.
