First Day of Sacred Year	March 24	Day 3 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Passover	April 6	Day 16 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Days of Unleavened Bread	April 7-13	Days 17-23 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days for religious convenience)
Pentecost	May 27	Day 7 of the lunar month (Not affected by postponements this year)
Feast of Trumpets	September 17	Day 2 of the lunar month (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)
Day of Atonement	September 26	Day 11 of the lunar month (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)
Feast of Tabernacles	October 1-7	Days 16-22 of the lunar month (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)
Last Great Day	October 8	Day 23 of the lunar month (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)

The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong. The Jewish calendar is used to provide the start of a month. The inherent Jewish postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Jewish customs, are accepted as divinely inspired.
