First Day of Sacred Year	April 1 (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)	Day 2 of the lunar month
Passover	April 14 (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)	Day 15 of the lunar month
Days of Unleavened Bread	April 15-21 (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)	Days 16-22 of the lunar month
Pentecost	June 8 (Not affected by postponements this year)	Day 11 of the lunar month
Feast of Trumpets	September 25 (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)	Day 2 of the lunar month
Day of Atonement	October 4 (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)	Day 11 of the lunar month
Feast of Tabernacles	October 9-15 (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)	Days 16-22 of the lunar month
Last Great Day	October 16 (Postponed 1 day for religious convenience)	Day 23 of the lunar month

The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong. The Jewish calendar authorized by the Sanhedrin in 359CE is used to provide the start of a month, not the astronomical conjunction. The inherent postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Judaic customs, i.e. the traditions of the elders, are preached as divinely inspired.
