Days of Unleavened Bread	April 4-10 (Postponed 1 day this year for religious convenience)	Days 16-22 of the lunar month
Pentecost	May 24	Day 7 of the lunar month (Not postponed this year)
Feast of Trumpets (1 Tishrei 5776 Jewish Calendar)	September 14 (Postponed 1 day this year for religious convenience)	Day 2 of the lunar month
Day of Atonement	September 23 (Postponed 1 day this year for religious convenience)	Day 11 of the lunar month
Feast of Tabernacles	Sept28-Oct4 (Postponed 1 day this year for religious convenience)	Days 16-22 of the lunar month
Last Great Day	October 5 (Postponed 1 day this year for religious convenience)	Day 23 of the lunar month

The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong. The Jewish calendar authorized by the Sanhedrin in 359CE is used to provide the start of a month. The inherent Jewish postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Jewish customs, are accepted by Mr Armstrong's followers as divinely inspired.

Jewish year 5775 is year 18 of the endlessly repeating 19 year metonic cycle.
