First Day of Sacred Year (1 Nisan 5776 Jewish Calendar)	April 9	Day 3 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for religious convenience)
Passover	April 22	Day 16 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for religious convenience)
Days of Unleavened Bread	April 23-29	Days 17-22 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for religious convenience)
Pentecost	June 12	Day 8 of the lunar month (Not postponed this year)
Feast of Trumpets (1 Tishrei 5777 Jewish Calendar)	October 3	Day 3 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for religious convenience)
Day of Atonement	October 12	Day 12 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for religious convenience)
Feast of Tabernacles	Oct 17-23	Days 17-23 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for religious convenience)
Last Great Day	October 24	Day 24 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for religious convenience)

The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong. The Jewish calendar authorized by the Sanhedrin in 359CE is used to provide the start of a month. The inherent Jewish postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Jewish customs, are accepted as divinely inspired.

Jewish year 5776 is year 19 of the endlessly repeating 19 year metonic cycle.

Jewish year 5777 is year 1 of the endlessly repeating 19 year metonic cycle.
