Feast of Trumpets (1 Tishrei 5781 Jewish Calendar)	September 19	Day 3 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for Jewish religious convenience)
Day of Atonement	September 28	Day 12 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for Jewish religious convenience)
Feast of Tabernacles	Oct 3-9	Days 17-23 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for Jewish religious convenience)
Last Great Day	October 10	Day 24 of the lunar month (Postponed 2 days this year for Jewish religious convenience)

The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong, viz the Jewish calendar authorized by the Sanhedrin in 359CE is used to provide the start of a month, not the time of the conjunction of the New Moon. The inherent Jewish postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Jewish customs, are accepted as divinely inspired.

Jewish year 5780 is year 4 of the endlessly repeating 19 year Metonic cycle. Jewish year 5781 is year 5 of the endlessly repeating 19 year Metonic cycle.
