Days of Unleavened Bread	April 16-22	Days 16-22 of the lunar month (Postponed 1 day this year for Jewish religious tradition)
Pentecost	June 5	Not based on Jewish Calendar method
Feast of Trumpets (1 Tishrei 5783 Jewish Calendar	September 26	Day 1 of the lunar month (No postponement this year)
Day of Atonement	October 5	Day 10 of the lunar month (No postponement this year)
Feast of Tabernacles	October 10-16	Days 15-21 of the lunar month (No postponement this year)
Last Great Day	October 17	Day 22 of the lunar month (No postponement this year)

The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong, viz the Jewish calendar authorized by the Sanhedrin in 359CE is used to provide the start of a month, not the time of the conjunction of the New Moon. The inherent Jewish postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Jewish customs, are accepted as divinely inspired. However Mr Armstrong rejected the Jewish teaching for determining Pentecost and used his own.

Jewish year 5782 is year 6 of the endlessly repeating 19 year Metonic cycle. Jewish year 5783 is year 7 of the endlessly repeating 19 year Metonic cycle.
