The above dates are in accordance with the teachings of Mr Herbert W Armstrong, viz the Jewish calendar authorized by the Sanhedrin in 359CE is used to provide the start of a month, not the time of the conjunction of the New Moon. The inherent Jewish postponements of Holy Days, which Rabbis have inserted to move Holy Days to more convenient dates when the original dates would have clashed with Jewish customs, do not occur this year.

Mr Armstrong rejected the Jewish teaching for determining Pentecost and used his own.

Jewish year 5784 is year 8 of the endlessly repeating 19 year Metonic cycle. Jewish year 5785 is year 9 of the endlessly repeating 19 year Metonic cycle.
